### Hebrews 11:1-3, 8-16 The Meaning of Faith

11 Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. <sup>2</sup> Indeed, by faith our ancestors received approval.<sup>3</sup> By faith we understand that the worlds were prepared by the word of God, so that what is seen was made from things that are not visible.

#### The Faith of Abraham

<sup>8</sup> By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to set out for a place that he was to receive as an inheritance; and he set out, not knowing where he was going. <sup>9</sup> By faith he stayed for a time in the land he had been promised, as in a foreign land, living in tents, as did Isaac and Jacob, who were heirs with him of the same promise. <sup>10</sup> For he looked forward to the city that has foundations, whose architect and builder is God. <sup>11</sup> By faith he received power of procreation, even though he was too old—and Sarah herself was barren—because he considered him faithful who had promised. <sup>12</sup> Therefore from one person, and this one as good as dead, descendants were born, "as many as the stars of heaven and as the innumerable grains of sand by the seashore." <sup>13</sup> All of these died in faith without having received the promises, but from a distance they saw and greeted them. They confessed that they were strangers and foreigners on the earth, <sup>14</sup> for people who speak in this way make it clear that they are seeking a homeland. <sup>15</sup> If they had been thinking of the land that they had left behind, they would have had opportunity to return. <sup>16</sup> But as it is, they desire a better country, that is, a heavenly one. Therefore God is not ashamed to be called their God; indeed, he has prepared a city for them.

# a note from Brother Jason...

Last Sunday morning when we read one of the Psalms for our call to worship, it struck me that what we are doing was what people had done for thousands of years. As we called and responded in the scripture reading, I recognized it as english words but realized that the language almost didn't matter. Regardless of the language, the Psalm has always been humanity's declaration that there is something that is worthy of worship. There's something bigger than us and for us to proclaim it Sunday was only a continuous proclamation as old as humanity itself:

Maybe I thought about this because the week before the family and I hosted a cumberland Presbytevian Japanese seminary student from Japan Presbytery, Ken Miyagi. Several times he prayed aloud in his native language, and while I didn't know specifically what he was praying for, I knew the general gist because I knew who he was praying to the worships God. The taith not only stretches beyond time, it stretches beyond geography, too.

That reminds me how interconnected we all are. Despite differences, despite understandings, and despite world-defined barriers, we are first and foremost creations of God. We are brothers and sisters in creation, all searching for God as best we can, hoping to see God as much as God allows.

Isn't that beautiful? Rather than individuals having to come to understandings on our own, we get to learn in communion with the ancients as well as from the four corners of the earth. Together with people across space and time we get to learn about God and pursue God's will for the world.

what an awesome privilege and responsibility that we are given! It's almost as if God trusts enough to do it, and has grace enough to overcome the damage we cause when we mess it up. either way, profise be that we get to be a part of it all. What better way to live a life?
