**Leader:** So he returned home to his father. And while he was still a long distance away, his father saw him coming.

**People:** Filled with love and compassion, he ran to his son, embraced him, and kissed him.

**Leader:** His son said to him, 'Father, I have sinned against both heaven and you, and I am no longer worthy of being called your son.'

**People:** "But his father said to the servants, 'Quick! Bring the finest robe in the house and put it on him. Get a ring for his finger, and sandals for his feet.

**Leader:** And kill the calf we have been fattening in the pen. We must celebrate with a feast,

**People:** for this son of mine was dead and has now returned to life. He was lost, but now he is found.' So the party began.

**Leader:** ...you husbands must love your wives with the same love Christ showed the church. He gave up his life for her to make her holy and clean, washed by baptism and God's word.

**People:** He did this to present her to himself as a glorious church without a spot or wrinkle or any other blemish. Instead, she will be holy and without fault.

**Leader:** In the same way, husbands ought to love their wives as they love their own bodies. For a man is actually loving himself when he loves his wife.

**People:** No one hates his own body but lovingly cares for it, just as Christ cares for his body, which is the church. And we are his body.

**Leader:** As the Scriptures say, "A man leaves his father and mother and is joined to his wife, and the two are united into one."

**People:** This is a great mystery, but it is an illustration of the way Christ and the church are one.

**Leader:** So again I say, each man must love his wife as he loves himself, and the wife must respect her husband.

**People:** Children, obey your parents because you belong to the Lord, for this is the right thing to do.

**Leader:** "Honor your father and mother."

This is the first of the Ten Commandments that ends with a promise.

**People:** And this is the promise: If you honor your father and mother, "you will live a long life, full of blessing."

**Leader:** And now a word to you fathers. Don't make your children angry by the way you treat them. Rather, bring them up with the discipline and instruction approved by the Lord.

(from Luke 15:20-24 NIV, Ephesians 5:25-33 NIV, & Ephesians 6:1-4 NIV)

Luke 8:11-15

11" This is the meaning of the parable: The seed is the word of God. 12 Those along the path are the ones who hear, and then the devil comes and takes away the word from their hearts, so that they may not believe and be saved. 13 Those on the rock are the ones who receive the word with joy when they hear it, but they have no root. They believe for a while, but in the time of testing they fall away. 14 The seed that fell among thorns stands for those who hear, but as they go on their way they are choked by life's worries, riches and pleasures, and they

do not mature. 15But the seed on good soil stands for those with a noble and good heart, who hear the word, retain it, and by persevering produce a crop.
