Sermon

Responding to the Call of God

Jonah 3:1-5, 10 (Psalm 62:5-12; Mark 1:14-20; I Corinthians 7:29-31)
(Maybe a more appropriate title would be "Answering the Call")

Introduction:

Jonah and his experience. What do you know about Jonah?

Big fish story? Is that the main point of this book?

Someone has said that the main point is God's love for all people.

I agree with that. But there is more than one message here.

The point I want to emphasize today is God calling Jonah and how Jonah responded, and the effect his action had on an entire city.

Our lesson begins where God call Jonah a second time.

Let's look back at the first call.

___ After that ordeal, Jonah was ready to obey.

But he did not want to. Last week I mentioned hearing many testimonies from preachers who did not want to be preachers, but were convinced that God wanted them. This was Jonah's predicament (situation).

Results of Jonah obeying God:

People repented

God spared them His planned destruction.

There are two calls today:

The call of God to be a witness for Him.

Do it.

The call to the person who is estranged from God.

Come to Him through faith in Jesus, the Christ (Savior) (Lord).
