ANNUAL REPORT 2005

Each year we turn to Columbia Presbytery and the General Assembly office an annual report. Our 2005 report showed eight gains and eight losses. Our membership remains at 292 and our active membership is 153. There were four professions of faith in Christ in 2005 and two infants were baptized.

The total income was \$251,101. We gave away \$26,690.00. A portion of that money went to our General Assembly denominational programs through Our United Outreach (OUO) to help support Bethel College, Memphis Theological Seminary, the Cumberland Presbyterian Children's Home, work of the Board of Missions, the Board of Christian Education, the Board of Finance, the General Assembly office, etc. Ten percent of our regular offering or undesignated income goes to OUO.

The rest was given to outreach projects through the outreach committee, Graceworks, the Grace Team, or local benevolent needs. Our United Outreach for 2005 - \$17,864.76.

Average worship attendance at two morning services was 147.5.




