Matthew 28:16-20; Luke 24:45-49; John 15:5-8

Introduction: Probably the most important thing that we can do for the kingdom of God is to lead people to be disciples of Jesus.

His parting instruction to His disciples were to make disciples.

The last words that they would ever hear from his mouth ...

He, Jesus, said of himself (Luke 19:10)

The Apostle Paul said of Him (1 Tim 1:15)

And another example of what he said of Himself (John 3:16-17)

Glorifying God is man's chief end or purpose, but people getting saved brings glory to God. Luke 15:5ff

A life full of sin and involved in willful sin does not /cannot honor God.

How to become a disciple of Jesus: or how to be saved from our sin.
The Gospel (from Evangelism Explosion)

Grace

Heaven is a free gift.

It is not earned or deserved

Man

Is a sinner; cannot save himself...

God

Is merciful-therefore does not want to punish us;

Is just-therefore must punish sin

Christ

Who He is-the infinite God-man

What he did-he paid for our sins and purchased a place in heaven for us which he offers as a free gift.

Faith

What it is not – mere intellectual assent nor temporal faith.

What it is – “trusting in Jesus Christ alone for our salvation”
