Exodus 34:29-35 (NIV) 29 When Moses came down from Mount Sinai with the two tablets of the Testimony in his hands, he was not aware that his face was radiant because he had spoken with the LORD. 30 When Aaron and all the Israelites saw Moses, his face was radiant, and they were afraid to come near him. 31 But Moses called to them; so Aaron and all the leaders of the community came back to him, and he spoke to them. 32 Afterward all the Israelites came near him, and he gave them all the commands the LORD had given him on Mount Sinai. 33 When Moses finished speaking to them, he put a veil over his face. 34 But whenever he entered the LORD's presence to speak with him, he removed the veil until he came out. And when he came out and told the Israelites what he had been commanded, 35 they saw that his face was radiant. Then Moses would put the veil back over his face until he went in to speak with the LORD

Luke 9:28-36 (NIV) 28 About eight days after Jesus said this, he took Peter, John and James with him and went up onto a mountain to pray. 29 As he was praying, the appearance of his face changed, and his clothes became as bright as a flash of lightning. 30 Two men, Moses and Elijah, 31 appeared in glorious splendor, talking with Jesus. They spoke about his departure, which he was about to bring to fulfillment at Jerusalem. 32 Peter and his companions were very sleepy, but when they became fully awake, they saw his glory and the two men standing with him. 33 As the men were leaving Jesus, Peter said to him, "Master, it is good for us to be here. Let us put up three shelters—one for you, one for Moses and one for Elijah." (He did not know what he was saying.) 34 While he was speaking, a cloud appeared and enveloped them, and they were afraid as they entered the cloud. 35 A voice came from the cloud, saying, "This is my Son, whom I have chosen; listen to him." 36 When the voice had spoken, they found that Jesus was alone. The disciples kept this to themselves, and told no one at that time what they had seen.

We Would See Jesus

Old Testament Lesson: Exodus 34: 29-35 & New Testament Lesson: Luke 9:28-36

Historical Background:

O.T. – Moses receiving the Ten Commandments the second time.
N.T. – Jesus takes three disciples to the mountain where he is transfigured before their eyes. Jesus has started toward Jerusalem where he would meet his death.

Goal: To call attention to the blessing of seeing God or being in His very near presence and experiencing His glory.

Introduction: We have heard Luke's account of the transfiguration. In this experience Jesus - The O.T Lesson tells us about Moses' experience with God on Mt. Sinai a second time. Consider the effects that meeting had on Moses.

Giving of the Law.	Shining (radiant) face.	The people feared him.
Veil over his face.	More than one trip before the Lord.	

Now to the N.T. lesson. Jesus took three disciples with him as he ascended the mountain. He was about to begin his last trip to Jerusalem and to the cross. Some say that ----- I invite you to look at v. 32. Maybe there is a lesson here about us and our experiencing the Glory of God. The word GLORY is found many times in the bible – One familiar reference is -----

Note: When the three disciples were able to see Jesus' glory.

What keeps us from seeing His glory or seeing Him in His glory?
