Galatians 3:1-14

1You foolish Galatians! Who has bewitched you? Before your very eyes Jesus Christ was clearly portrayed as crucified. 2. I would like to learn just one thing from you: Did you receive the Spirit by observing the law, or by believing what you heard? 3Are you so foolish? After beginning with the Spirit, are you now trying to attain your goal by human effort? 4Have you suffered so much for nothing—if it really was for nothing? 5Does God give you His Spirit and work miracles among you because you observe the law, or because you believe what you heard? 6Consider Abraham: "He believed God, and it was credited to him as righteousness. 7Understand, then, that those who believe are children of Abraham. 8The Scripture foresaw that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, and announced the gospel in advance to Abraham: "All nations will be blessed through you. 9So those who have faith are blessed along with Abraham, the man of faith. 10All who rely on observing the law are under a curse, for it is written: "Cursed is everyone who does not continue to do everything written in the Book of the Law. 11Clearly no one is justified before God by the law, because, "The righteous will live by faith. 12The law is not based on faith; on the contrary, "The man who does these things will live by them. 13Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us, for it is written: "Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree. 14He redeemed us in order that the blessing given to Abraham might come to the Gentiles through Christ Jesus, so that by faith we might receive the promise of the Spirit.

LEADER: The Word of God for the People of God.

PEOPLE: Thanks be to God.

God Helps the Helpless

(Man's Inability to Save Himself and God's Remedy)

Galatians 3:1-14(NIV)

Purpose: To show that the bible tells us that we cannot save ourselves and that our salvation depends on Jesus, and invite people to trust Jesus.

Setting: The Apostle Paul is writing to Christians at Galatia explaining **again** that salvation from sin is through faith in Jesus and not by works/obeying the law.

Looking at what Paul writes:

Call Galatians foolish. v.1

Asks them to tell him how they received the Spirit: By law or faith. v.2

Asks them if they have changed to trusting in the flesh. v.3

Tells them that only those who are of faith are really sons of Abraham. v.7

People under law are under curse. v.10

The just live by faith. V.11

Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law becoming a curse for us. v.13

Paul writes about our inability to save ourselves:

To Titus 3:5

To Galatians 2:16

To Ephesians 2:8, 9

To Romans 3:20

Writer of Proverbs says 14:12

The prophet Isaiah says 64:6

God's solution for our sin:

Christ died for us. Rom 5:8

A gift of God Rom 6:23

Jesus is the WAY, Jn 14:6

Salvation in no other, Acts 4:12

He came to save the lost. Lu 19:10
