# The Difference Trusting Christ Makes

John 3:14-18(NIV)

**<u>Purpose</u>**: To encourage the people who do not trust Jesus as their Savior to do so and to encourage those who do to do trust Him to tell others about Him.

The role of the church is to lead people to Jesus, who is the Christ, so that \_\_\_\_\_

That is our purpose, our reason for being. Mark 16:14-16; Matt 28:18-20, Luke 24:45-48. This glorifies God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

What is so important about being saved? Why was/is our salvation so important that God sent Jesus to make it possible.

For this life:

The best kind of relationships, Help in getting through life's difficulties, Fear is gone(or should be).

For the life to come (there is an eternity): No condemnation Saved from perishing, hell, torment; Saved from life without God Save to life with God.

Invitation: To claim salvation and eternal life through faith in Jesus.
