Ephesians 2:19-20

19 Consequently, you are no longer foreigners and aliens, but fellow citizens with God's people and members of God's household, 20 built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the chief cornerstone.

1 Cor. 12:12,13,14,18,19,20,22,28, (also below, not to be read, 15-17,21,29)

12 The body is a unit, though it is made up of many parts; and though all its parts are many, they form one body. So it is with Christ. 13 For we were all baptized by^[c] one Spirit into one body—whether Jews or Greeks, slave or free—and we were all given the one Spirit to drink. 14 Now the body is not made up of one part but of many 18 But in fact God has arranged the parts in the body, every one of them, just as he wanted them to be. 19 If they were all one part, where would the body be? 20 As it is, there are many parts, but one body. 22 On the contrary, those parts of the body that seem to be weaker are indispensable, 28 And in the church God has appointed first of all apostles, second prophets, third teachers, then workers of miracles, also those having gifts of healing, those able to help others, those with gifts of administration, and those speaking in different kinds of tongues.

I Peter 2:4-9

4 As you come to him, the living Stone—rejected by men but chosen by God and precious to him— 5 you also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood, offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. 6 For in Scripture it says: "See, I lay a stone in Zion, a chosen and precious cornerstone, and the one who trusts in him will never be put to shame." 7 Now to you who believe, this stone is precious. But to those who do not believe, "The stone the builders rejected has become the capstone," 8 and, "A stone that causes men to stumble and a rock that makes them fall." They stumble because they disobey the message—which is also what they were destined for. 9 But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.

If the whole body were an ear, where would the sense of smell be?) (21 The eye cannot say to the hand, "I don't need you!" And the head cannot say to the feet, "I don't need you!") (2 9Are all apostles? Are all prophets? Are all teachers? Do all work miracles?) .

Sermon Outline: Church Leaders and Followers

I Cor. 12: 12-20, 22, 28; Eph. 2: 19-2 ; I Pet. 2: 4-9

Introduction: In I Cor. 12 the Apostle Paul writes about the body, human body. This was something the listeners could relate to in Paul's day and we can relate to in our day our day. Paul discusses how the parts of the human body each have a place in the body and how they work together so that the body functions as it was created to function.

He uses this to illustrate how the church, the body of Christ Jesus, should function and is intended to function.

I find many people unhappy with organized religion or do not believe in organized religion. What some of them are saying is that they are unhappy with the church.

But the bible teaches that the church of Jesus Christ is organized. The passages we have chosen for today show one aspect of how the church is to be organized.

In Ephesians, the Apostle Paul, and in I Peter, the Apostle Peter, speak of a building. Again, this was something the people of their day could understand and we can understand. We can look around us and see building like the writers are writing about.

They way a stone or brick building is constructed illustrates how the church functions.

These passages are appropriate as we think about the leaders of the local church and the congregation's relationship to them and the relationship of us all to Jesus.

In the body All do not have the same function but all are necessary to the operation or proper function of the body

In the building all are necessary to make the body

In Ephesians we read about the people being the Temple of God, the dwelling of God by His Spirit.

Peter writes of the members being chosen by God, precious to him.

Living stones in His spiritual house

Priest hood, offering sacrifices.

Church : Jesus, elders and preacher, members.

This is especially appropriate as we think of building or adding to the kingdom of God.

Every person is important and needed.
