Each box costs about \$30. (2) Food For Local Families- we help any time of the year we're made aware of a family in crisis. Depending on the size of the family, we usually spend about \$200. (3) Operation Smile- this group can do an operation to repair a child's disfigured face for \$240. In other words, you or your Sunday school class, etc. can save a child from a lifetime of ridicule or, in some cases even death, by donating this amount of money. What a small price to pay to change a life!
