22 Immediately Jesus made the disciples get into the boat and go on ahead of him to the other side, while he dismissed the crowd. 23 After he had dismissed them, he went up on a mountainside by himself to pray. When evening came, he was there alone. 24 but the boat was already a considerable distance from land. buffeted by the waves because the wind was against it. 25 During the fourth watch of the night Jesus went out to them, walking on the lake. 26 When the disciples saw him walking on the lake, they were terrified. "It's a ghost," they said, and cried out in fear. 27 But Jesus immediately said to them: "Take courage! It is I. Don't be afraid." 28 "Lord, if it's you," Peter replied, "tell me to come to you on the water." 29 "Come," he said. "You of little faith," he said, "why did you doubt?" 32 And when they climbed into the boat, the wind died down. 33 Then those who were in the boat worshiped him, saying, "Truly you are the Son of God."

Three weeks ago and two weeks ago - What God's kingdom is like

Anybody here ever had that experience?

According to John's gospel, the people who Jesus had fed at the feeding of the 5000 wanted to make Him king by force. He would have none of it. He sent the disciples away, across the sea, while he went to the mountain to pray.

About 3 A.M., as a storm tossed the boat the disciples were in and they were in distress, Jesus came to them by walking on the water.

Even when Jesus sends us out, there are storms to face.

Jesus comes to us in the storms of life.

We may not recognize that it is Jesus coming to us.

Peter's experience at walking on the water.

Bold, trusting, fear, sinking, saved by Jesus.
