21 From that time on Jesus began to explain to his disciples that he must go to Jerusalem and suffer many things at the hands of the elders, chief priests and teachers of the law, and that he must be killed and on the third day be raised to life. 22 Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him. # It Is Not Wise To Argue With Jesus

Matthew 16:21-28

Have you ever said something that you wish that you had never said? I Have. 1. 3 weeks ago; 2. A few years back; 3. Wed. Did not just start. Hopefully not a pattern. Hopefully just random Incidents. No harm ever intended.

Lesson today: Disciple Peter saying something he should not have said. Jesus was explaining the suffering that He was facing. Peter rebuked Him.

We don't rebuke Jesus.

Jesus rebuked Peter. Maybe a shouting match, or at least raised voices. Read Jesus' response to Peter's rebuke: 1.,2., 3., This word from Peter followed his great expression of faith.

Ever think about rebuking Jesus? Don't. You won't win.

The call to us is to follow.
