Matthew 22:34-46

34 Hearing that Jesus had silenced the Sadducees, the Pharisees got together. 35 One of them, an expert in the law, tested him with this question: 36 "Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?" 37 Jesus replied: " 'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' 38 This is the first and greatest commandment. 39 And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' 40 All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments." 41 While the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them, 42 "What do you think about the Christ? Whose son is he?" "The son of David," they replied. 43 He said to them, "How is it then that David, speaking by the Spirit, calls him 'Lord'? For he says, 44 " 'The Lord said to my Lord: "Sit at my right hand until I put your enemies under your feet." ' 45 If then David calls him 'Lord,' how can he be his son?" 46 No one could say a word in reply, and from that day on no one dared to ask him any more questions.

Home Base for Christians

Matthew 22:34-46

In the game of baseball and softball you have to touch **HOME BASE** before you can score.

Children's game of chase: There is safety in **HOME BASE**.

In war when doing battle warriors needed to often return to **HOME BASE**.

There is a home base for Christians to which we must return often.

I see our lesson from Mt. 22 as being about our **HOME BASE**.

A Pharisee came to Jesus and asked him which was the GREATEST COMMANDMENT in the law (first 5 books of the bible).

How would we answer this question?

Jesus' answer. Jesus replied: " 'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' " 38 This is the first and greatest commandment. 39 And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' 40 All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments."

Love God. Love your neighbor (and self). That is **HOME BASE**.

Jesus added a word about the Messiah: That He (Messiah) is the Son of God. (Not merely a descendent of David). And that's **HOME BASE**.

You and **HOME BASE**
