### When Giving Leads To Thanksgiving

II Corinthians 9:6-15

Introduction: When the Christians in Jerusalem experienced persecution (Acts 8) many scattered. Except the apostles. They remained, but were poor. There was famine in Judea.

The apostle Paul challenged the other churches with which he had contact to receive an offering for the Christians in Jerusalem/Judea.

The church at Corinth had made a pledge or commitment to help:

(II Corinthians 8:11-12) but had not carried through.

- 1. Paul encourages the Corinthian Christians to finish what they had started.
- 2. We do not lose when we give to charity. V. 6,7,8.
- 3. People can't out give God. V. 10, 11.
- 4. Results of giving to charity: poor are helped; poor offer praise and glory to God. V. 12,13.
- 5. Receivers of our giving will offer prayers for us. V. 14
- 6. We offer thanks to God for His gift to us, Jesus, the one who saves us for heaven. V. 15
- 7. Claiming the gift of God, Jesus.
