## John 20:19-31

<sup>19</sup> On the evening of that first day of the week, when the disciples were together, with the doors locked for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you!" <sup>20</sup> After he said this, he showed them his hands and side. The disciples were overjoyed when they saw the Lord. <sup>21</sup> Again Jesus said, "Peace be with you! As the Father has sent me, I am sending you." 22 And with that he breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit. 23 If you forgive anyone his sins, they are forgiven; if you do not forgive them, they are not forgiven." <sup>24</sup>Now Thomas (called Didymus), one of the Twelve, was not with the disciples when Jesus came. <sup>25</sup> So the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord!" But he said to them, "Unless I see the nail marks in his hands and put my finger where the nails were, and put my hand into his side, I will not believe it." 26 A week later his disciples were in the house again, and Thomas was with them. Though the doors were locked, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you!" 27 Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here: see my hands, Reach out your hand and put it into my side. Stop doubting and believe." 28 Thomas said to him, "My Lord and my God!" <sup>29</sup> Then Jesus told him, "Because you have seen me, you have believed; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed." 30 Jesus did many other miraculous signs in the presence of his disciples, which are not recorded in this book. <sup>31</sup> But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.

#### Visited by the Risen Jesus

John 20:19-31 (Luke 24:13-49)

Goal: To help the unbeliever to come to faith in Jesus and the believer to be strengthened in his/her faith.

Introduction: Those disciples of Jesus did not readily grasp the idea of Jesus being risen from the dead.

What is a good thing to do on Easter afternoon and evening?

Mark, Luke and John tell us of the action of some of the followers of Jesus on the afternoon and evening of that first Easter.

First: Luke's account of two unnamed disciples who walked to Emmaus the afternoon of the resurrection.

Second: Back in Jerusalem some disciple were behind locked doors and Jesus appeared in their midst.

Third: Thomas

Jesus told Thomas, "You believe because you have seen me. Blessed are those who believe without seeing me."
