¹¹ "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep.
¹² The hired hand is not the shepherd who owns the sheep. So when he sees the wolf coming, he abandons the sheep and runs away. Then the wolf attacks the flock and scatters it. ¹³ The man runs away because he is a hired hand and cares nothing for the sheep. ¹⁴ "I am the good shepherd; I know my sheep and my sheep know me— ¹⁵ just as the Father knows me and I know the Father—and I lay down my life for the sheep. ¹⁶ I have other sheep that are not of this sheep pen. I must bring them also. They too will listen to my voice, and there shall be one flock and one shepherd. ¹⁷ The reason my Father loves me is that I lay down my life—only to take it up again. ¹⁸ No one takes it from me, but I lay it down of my own accord. I have authority to lay it down and authority to take it up again. This command I received from my Father."

Shepherds cared for Sheep.
Sheep were for benefit of Shepherds: food, clothing

Jesus Came like a shepherd.

4 things about Jesus as our shepherd
First, He is a genuine shepherd.
Second, He knows his sheep.
Third, the Good Shepherd also includes other sheep.
Fourth, the shepherd lays down his life for his sheep.

The sacrament of the Lord's Supper was given us by Jesus to help us remember that He gave his life to save us from sin and Satan.
