⁹"As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. What's About Love!

John 15:9-17 (I John 4:7-21; 5:1-6)

Introduction: Two things that God's word tells us.

What God has done for us.

What He expects (requires) of us.

Today's gospel lesson is about what God has done and is doing for us and what he requires of us.

And so is The reference from the epistle. God Loves us and calls (commands) us to love Him and one another.

Love.

Message of God's love to people is spread throughout the bible.

Two verses seem to sum it up. John 3:16 and Romans 5:8

The apostle John wrote much about love, loving one another.

To love is the greatest thing the Christian can do. Jesus said it. The greatest commandment is to love God and the second greatest commandment is to love our neighbor.

Love. What it is.

Love is greater than faith and hope.

Jesus on the cross showed great love for those who were killing Him.
