⁶"I have revealed you to those whom you gave me out of the world. They were yours; you gave them to me and they have obeyed your word. ⁷Now they know that everything you have given me comes from you. ⁸For I gave them the words you gave me and they accepted them. They knew with certainty that I came from you, and they believed that you sent me. ⁹I pray for them. I am not praying for the world, but for those you have given me, for they are yours. ¹⁰All I have is yours, and all you have is mine. And glory has come to me through them. ¹¹I will remain in the world no longer, but they are still in the world, and I am coming to you. Holy Father, protect them by the power of your name—the name you gave me—so that they may be one as we are one. ¹²While I was with them, I protected them and kept them safe by that name you gave me. John 17:6-19

Introduction : When it is time to go there are a number of things to do, affairs to be put in order.

In our Scripture we find Jesus about to return to heaven. John 13:31-33.

John 17 is the prayer Jesus prayed as part of His getting things in order.

v. 1-5 - about His work on earth being finished and His returning to heaven.

v. 6-19 – about His disciples

v. 20-26 – all believers.

We focus on v. 6-19

God gave Jesus the disciples. v. 6

Jesus gave the disciples God's word. V. 6-8

Disciples received the Word, believed it and kept it. V. 6-8

Relation of disciples to world. V.9-16

Disciples sanctified, consecrated, (set apart) dedicated.

Role or purpose of disciples—Continuation of mission God had given
