Merciful God, of what do we boast? Can we truly say with Paul that we do not boast about ourselves or our achievements? Does the danger in such thinking lie in the next step - the thought that we can do anything - or all things by ourselves?

Forgive us the times when we ignore You, O God, and depend on our own strength to do things our own way.

Paul talks about power being made perfect in weakness.

Mark 6:1-13

¹ Jesus left there and went to his hometown, accompanied by his disciples. ² When the Sabbath came, he began to teach in the synagogue, and many who heard him were amazed. "Where did this man get these things?" they asked. "What's this wisdom that has been given him, that he even does miracles! ³ Isn't this the carpenter? Isn't this Mary's son and the brother of James, Joseph, Judas and Simon? Aren't his sisters here with us?" And they took offense at him. ⁴ Jesus said to them, "Only in his hometown, among his relatives and in his own house is a prophet without honor." ⁵ He could not do any miracles there, except lay his hands on a few sick people and heal them. ⁶ And he was amazed at their lack of faith. Then Jesus went around teaching from village to village. ⁷ Calling the Twelve to him, he sent them out two by two and gave them authority over evil spirits. ⁸ These were his instructions: "Take nothing for the journey except a staff—no bread, no bag, no money in your belts. ⁹ Wear sandals but not an extra tunic. ¹⁰ Whenever you enter a house, stay there until you leave that town. ¹¹ And if any place will not welcome you or listen to you, shake the dust off your feet when you leave, as a testimony against them." ¹² They went out and preached that people should repent. ¹³ They drove out many demons and anointed many sick people with oil and healed them.

There's Danger In Rejecting Jesus

Mark 6:1-13 (Matthew 13:53-58; Luke 4:14-30)

Have you ever been rejected?

A message about Jesus being rejected and how He dealt with it.

Jesus' hometown. Where he had grown up. Nazareth, in Galilee. The Synagogue. He was teaching.

First the people were amazed.

Then they took offense at Him. We go to Luke's gospel to see a possible reason.

The people of Nazareth wanted to do Jesus in.

Results of rejecting Jesus.

Jesus did not allow this rejection to stop his ministry.

People still reject Jesus.
