<sup>7</sup> The law of the LORD is perfect, reviving the soul. The statutes of the LORD are trustworthy, making wise the simple. <sup>8</sup> The precepts of the LORD are right, giving joy to the heart. The commands of the LORD are radiant, giving light to the eyes. <sup>9</sup> The fear of the LORD is pure, enduring forever. The ordinances of the LORD are sure and altogether righteous. <sup>10</sup> They are more precious than gold, than much pure gold; they are sweeter than honey, than honey from the comb. <sup>11</sup> By them is your servant warned; in keeping them there is great reward.

**Psalm 19:7-11; 2 Timothy 3:16; 2 Peter 1:19-21**

Introduction: You probably have seen Joel Osteen raise his Bible and ask everyone in the audience to raise their Bibles in the air. He, along with the congregation, chant the following words:

**"This is my Bible. I am what it says I am. I have what it says I have. I can do what it says I can do. Today I will be taught the word of God. I boldly confess my mind is alert, my heart is receptive; I'll never be the same. In Jesus name, God bless you."**

**THE BIBLE**

The Bible is the world's greatest book. A knowledge of the Bible is the mark of a truly educated person. Learning how to read and study the bible is necessary for an understanding of the Christian faith.

Edwin Hodder, back in 1863, wrote a hymn about the Bible

**Thy Word is Like a Garden, Lord**

Psalm 119: selected verses

Psalm 19:7-11

The bible (scriptures) is a record of God's word and action in creation, providence, judgment and redemption.

We believe that God inspired people to write the scriptures.

In the scriptures God speaks about creation, sin, judgment, salvation, the church and the growth of believers.

The scriptures are the infallible rule of faith and practice, the authoritative guide for Christians.

The scriptures should be understood in the light of the birth, life, death and resurrection of Jesus of Nazareth.

God's Spirit enables us to understand God's word.
