**Genesis 3:1-13**

<sup>1</sup> Now the serpent was more crafty than any of the wild animals the LORD God had made. He said to the woman, "Did God really say, 'You must not eat from any tree in the garden?'"  
<sup>2</sup> The woman said to the serpent, "We may eat fruit from the trees in the garden, <sup>3</sup> but God did say, 'You must not eat fruit from the tree that is in the middle of the garden, and you must not touch it, or you will die.'" <sup>4</sup> "You will not surely die," the serpent said to the woman. <sup>5</sup> "For God knows that when you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil." <sup>6</sup> When the woman saw that the fruit of the tree was good for food and pleasing to the eye, and also desirable for gaining wisdom, she took some and ate it. She also gave some to her husband, who was with her, and he ate it. <sup>7</sup> Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they realized they were naked; so they sewed fig leaves together and made coverings for themselves. <sup>8</sup> Then the man and his wife heard the sound of the LORD God as he was walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and they hid from the LORD God among the trees of the garden. <sup>9</sup> But the LORD God called to the man, "Where are you?" <sup>10</sup> He answered, "I heard you in the garden, and I was afraid because I was naked; so I hid." <sup>11</sup> And he said, "Who told you that you were naked? Have you eaten from the tree that I commanded you not to eat from?"  
<sup>12</sup> The man said, "The woman you put here with me—she gave me some fruit from the tree, and I ate it." <sup>13</sup> Then the LORD God said to the woman, "What is this you have done?" The woman said, "The serpent deceived me, and I ate."

**Rebels: They Were/We Are**

Genesis 3:1-13; 6:5  
Two kinds of rebels: Those without a cause and those with a cause.  
1955 movie with James Dean: Rebel Without a Cause  
Adam and Eve and Satan: Did they have a cause?

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth and animals --- and PEOPLE. Life could not have been better, but Satan and Adam and Eve could not leave well enough alone. The people God created rebelled against Him. God told Adam and Eve the things that would be best for them. Satan tempted them to do otherwise and they followed him, ignoring what God had said. Rebels!! The relationship between God and His people was broken.

Although Adam and Eve sinned, God continued to love them.

The sin of Adam and Eve even touches us. Because they sinned, disobeying God's Word, not trusting Him, we (you and I) became separated from God. Romans 5:12  
We, too, have done wrong, sinned, rebelled against God, etc. Rebels!! Sin entered the world through one man, and we have followed his example.

Although we sin, God continues to love us.
