The purpose of church government is to aid the church in performing its mission. The officers (leaders) serve the church by making decisions that will "guide the life and ministry," of the church.

The scripture does not give a detailed form of church govt., but affirms a govt. of a connectal nature.

Local session (active elders and minister) are the basic unit of representative form of govt.

The Session is responsible to lead the members in ministries which belong to the church.

Being effective in ministry requires a good spiritual condition: Worship, study/understand principal teaching of Bible, unity of spirit, determination to witness to the gospel, and commitment to minister to people in need.

Pastor and elders are responsible for exercising such pastoral care of people to enable the congregation to fulfill its mission.

Remember those who are homebound or in Nursing Homes, ill and in pain. Pray for our troops as they serve around the world. Pray that God will safeguard them and provide for their needs, whether physical, spiritual or emotional. Pray for peace for the Cumberland Presbyterian Churches in Buenaventura, Columbia, South America. (Church Bombings)
