## **CARNIVAL FOR KIDS THIS SATURDAY!!**

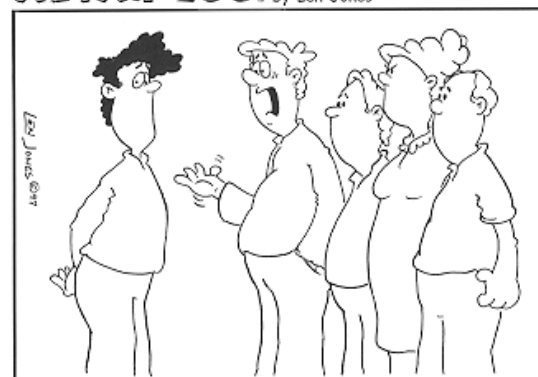
