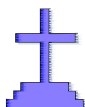

OUTREACH MEETING

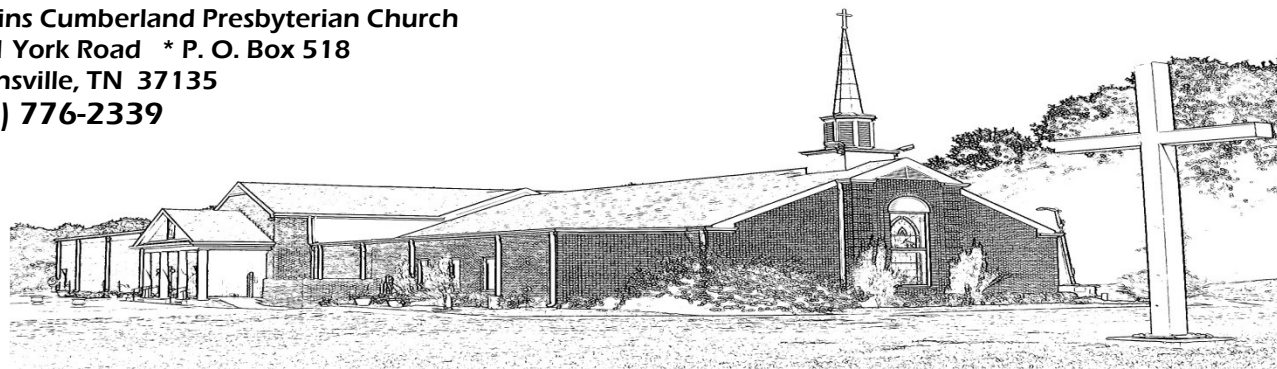

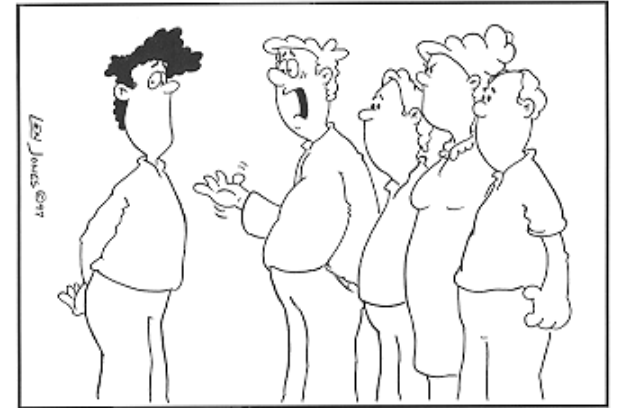
