

# Call Sunday: Prayer & Discernment for Midweek Ministry

Last Sunday twenty or more interested individuals showed up for our evening meeting, and the presence of the Lord was truly in the middle of everything that took place. I am happy to announce we have a Midweek Ministry Leadership Team in place, and they have already begun working toward having everything ready to go this fall. Please be in prayer for this team, and for how you may become involved, giving of your own gifts and abilities during midweek this fall and spring.

Midweek ministry will consist of two twelve-week semesters. Having fall and spring semesters allows for full enjoyment, but provides a Christmas break and spring/summer break that protects everyone from burn-out. It is our hope that many of you will choose to get involved with Midweek ministry. Most ministry positions are for both semesters, and most are only 25 to 40 minute time commitments.

Midweek provides ministry for everyone. We want to provide Wednesday night bible study for adults who enjoy worship and study, but we also hope to add another opportunity after supper called "Conversation and Coffee", for those who would like to continue visiting and enjoying fellowship in a relaxed atmosphere.

The four parts of the midweek evening are bible study, activities, dinner hour, and worship. Please allow me to share with you the areas of need for the midweek ministry.

- We need bible study teachers from senior high to nursery. (25 minute time commitment)
- We need activities leaders from senior high to nursery. (25 minute time commitment)
- We need worship leaders from senior high to nursery. (25 minute time commitment)
- We need a set-up team to come in on Tuesday night and set up tables. (Estimate 30 minutes)
- We need a décor team to come in on Wednesday to decorate the meal area. (Estimate 45 minutes)
- We need a prep team to set the tables for dinner. (Estimate 40 minutes)
- We need table parents for each table for relationships and leadership (40 minutes)
- We need a cooking team. (Estimate 2 to 3 hours)
- We need a clean-up team for after meal clean-up (estimate 1 hour)
- We need a tear down team to clean gym. (Estimate 40 minutes)
- We need three people to be Care Coaches to handle discipline (25 minutes)

These are the needs of midweek ministry. Every opportunity is one that offers time to be together with others to accomplish a need. It becomes a time to build new relationships or strengthen old ones. This ministry may seem too big for one person, but together we can create something special for the entire church.

Please make your involvement in midweek ministry a matter of prayer. A few weeks from now we will plan a "Call Sunday". The Sunday prior to "Call Sunday" a ministry sign-up flyer will be in your bulletin. We will explain how we would like for you to discern through prayer where you could see yourself participating in midweek ministry. Then, on "Call Sunday" the same flyer will be in your bulletin again, and we will ask you to put your name beside the area where you would be willing to serve. Then we will ask you to bring your sign-up flyer and lay it on the communion table during worship. I am sharing this with you now to give you as much time as possible to pray and discern where you could help best. Thank you for your consideration in this ministry matter.
