WEDNESDAY NIGHT MINISTRY BEGINS SEPTEMBER 21ST!!

We're very enthusiastic about our upcoming Wednesday night ministry and hope you are too! Please join us **September 21st** as we start the Fall Semester with our **Rock City (name of the new program,) Kick-Off Celebration**. Keep in mind the program is for adults as well as children/youth. Registration forms will be available on our web-site and at church next Sunday, so each family planning to attend can pre-register before starting the program.

Thank you for responding to "**Call Sunday**". It is exciting to see how many ministry positions have been filled, but we still need help in a couple of areas.

We need table parents. A table parent sits with a particular age group each week, and participates with their table in conversation, fun and games, and helps each child feel included (45 minutes).

We need ministry to our toddlers. Jo Proctor is our nursery attendant throughout the Rock City evening, but we need 4 leaders to provide the 4 segments of ministry. We need someone to tell a bible story (25 minutes), someone to help with an easy craft, coloring, or game (25 minutes), and someone to sing with the children (25 minutes). We will also need someone to help the children with their meal (40 minutes).

Finally, we need a Bible study teacher for the 3-5th graders. (25 minutes).

Parental involvement is one of the components that make's Rock City such a special ministry. We are asking at least one parent from each family whose children are involved in Rock City to participate in Rock City midweek ministry in some capacity. Parents, your ministry could be one to adults or it could be table setup on Tuesday night, but parental involvement in the midweek ministry that is special to your children is what communicates something special to your children. Youth need to see mom, dad, or both showing interest in ministry that is important to them. It builds the family and the family of God. We look forward to all God is about to do.
