THE JENKINS JOURNEY

Wisdom and Instruction for Life

Proverbs 4:5-13: 20-23

5 Get wisdom; get insight; do not forget, and do not turn away from the words of my mouth. 6 Do not forsake her, and she will keep you; love her, and she will guard you. 7 The beginning of wisdom is this: Get wisdom, and whatever you get, get insight. 8 Prize her highly, and she will exalt you; she will honor you if you embrace her. 9 She will place on your head a graceful garland; she will bestow on you a beautiful crown." 10 Hear, my son, and accept my words, that the years of your life may be many. 11 I have taught you the way of wisdom; I have led you in the paths of uprightness. 12 When you walk, your step will not be hampered, and if you run, you will not stumble. 13 Keep hold of instruction; do not let go; guard her, for she is your life.... 20 My son, be attentive to my words; incline your ear to my sayings. 21 Let them not escape from your sight; keep them within your heart. 22 For they are life to those who find them, and healing to all their flesh. 23 Keep your heart with all vigilance, for from it flow the springs of life.

Get wisdom, honor and embrace her. Hold on to instruction, do not let her go, guard her, she is your life. Do not let wisdom and instruction escape from your sight, keep them within your heart.

Have you ever thought about wisdom as a person? What about instruction? It is even more difficult to think of instruction as a person. Especially for students! The Proverb is talking about Godly wisdom and Godly instruction and the powerful personification they take on as they flow to us from God's presence.

We are told to get wisdom. How? Honor and embrace her. Honor is displayed best through obedience, but an embrace is personal. Everybody understands the language of the embrace. No matter who we embrace we experience warm loving feelings that communicate our level of connection. On the other hand, I think of Jacob who fought with the angel through the night, but it was not a "knock down drag out" kind of fight, but one where Jacob was determined to embrace the angel and not let go until he received a blessing. He must have held on to the angel for hours until the angel finally blessed him. I think this is the embrace we need with wisdom. One that says I will not let go not matter what.

The same is true with instruction. Hold on and do not let her go, but this goes a step further. We are told to guard her because she is our life. When it comes to learning most people try to stay current, brush up a little here and there, but for the most part we are in maintenance mode. We studied when we were young and now we are coasting through life. The proverb says instruction is our life. In other words, to experience the full abundant intentions of God for our life we must follow instruction to the very end of life. We must guard instruction and work to keep it before us always. This is where time spent in God's word becomes so valuable. God's word is our instruction book. We gather wisdom and instruction from two sources; the holy scriptures, and God's Spirit specking to us through various ways.

Keep your heart with all vigilance. Why? When we treat wisdom and instruction with the honor and respect revealed in this proverb both sink deep into our own hearts. These words of life intertwine with our spirits, and the work of the Holy Spirit within us, resulting in springs of life welling up out of our hearts to keep, exalt, and honor us, enfolding around us as a graceful garland, and bestowing on us a beautiful crown. The work of God wisdom and instruction is intended to flow up out of us to keep and bless us as we do God's will.

James 1:5 If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him, but let him ask in faith From my heart to yours, Jonathan
