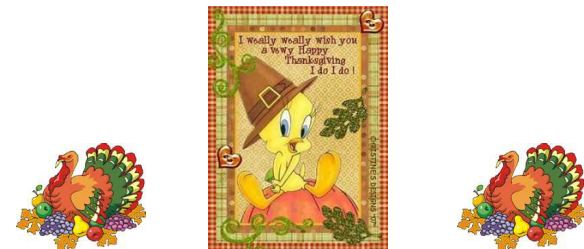
Mark your Calendar now for our annual **Thanksgiving Dinner.**
