What is our ministry???

Our praise band sings a song, "All Year Long Song". I hear a question in this song: Why not do the things we do at Christmas all the time???? Heal the hurt and keep the hungry fed!

What can I do to bring about the answer to my question?? I can find the ministry that God has prepared for me. There are people in our church who are stepping out. We have a new Sunday visitation starting, focusing on our shut-ins. The praise band will be ministering at the rescue mission. Patrick and our youth will have a coffee house for teens and college age. Our outreach committee will have several projects to help others this year.

Can we do more? I think we can, no, I know we can. Maybe God has been calling you to a ministry. We have more people in need since the economy has turned. What can we do?

We have needs for the ministries we already do. Help with Rock City, teach Sunday School, lead a children's worship. We have committees that already do a lot of work, but so much more can be done if we all work together. Maybe God has given you a special gift that you can use to make God's ministry at Jenkins Church more effective. Some church leaders say that 20% of church members do 80% of the work. I think we are better than that at Jenkins, and can do better still!!!

You might think that you have so little to give, but little becomes much when you place it in God's hands. I went several times to help in Pensacola, FL. after hurricane Ivan. There were 49,000 roofs damaged by Ivan. Our groups helped replace or repair 30-40 of these roofs. In the grand scheme we did not do much, but if you ask the individuals that we helped, they would call it miraculous.

A story is told of a man who went down to a beach after such a storm. Washed up on the beach were thousands of star fish. One lonely man was throwing them back one by one. The man told this lonely man that he wasn't doing much good. He replied as he threw another star fish back in the water, "well I saved that one"!!

Maybe in our lifetime we can only save one, there is rejoicing in Heaven when each one is saved! What is your ministry?? God has a job for each of us, we may be the only one with the gifts God has given for that particular job, answer His call today, there is work to do!!!
