¹⁸ "To the angel of the church in Thyatira write:

These are the words of the Son of God, whose eyes are like blazing fire and whose feet are like burnished bronze. ¹⁹ I know your deeds, your love and faith, your service and perseverance, and that you are now doing more than you did at first. ²⁰ Nevertheless, I have this against you: You tolerate that woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess. By her teaching she misleads my servants into sexual immorality and the eating of food sacrificed to idols. ²¹ I have given her time to repent of her immorality, but she is unwilling. ²² So I will cast her on a bed of suffering, and I will make those who commit adultery with her suffer intensely, unless they repent of her ways. ²³ I will strike her children dead. Then all the churches will know that I am he who searches hearts and minds, and I will repay each of you according to your deeds. ²⁴ Now I say to the rest of you in Thyatira, to you who do not hold to her teaching and have not learned Satan's so-called deep secrets (I will not impose any other burden on you): ²⁵ Only hold on to what you have until I come. ²⁶ To him who overcomes and does my will to the end, I will give authority over the nations— ²⁷ 'He will rule them with an iron scepter; he will dash them to pieces like pottery' just as I have received authority from my Father. ²⁸ I will also give him the morning star. ²⁹ He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.

Trust the Lord and Be Blessed

Jeremiah 17:5 - 8 (NKJV) ⁵Thus says the LORD: “Cursed *is* the man who trusts in man and makes flesh his strength, whose heart departs from the LORD. ⁶For he shall be like a shrub in the desert, and shall not see when good comes, but shall inhabit the parched places in the wilderness, *in* a salt land *which is* not inhabited. ⁷“Blessed *is* the man who trusts in the LORD, and whose hope is the LORD. ⁸For he shall be like a tree planted by the waters, which spreads out its roots by the river, and will not fear when heat comes; but its leaf will be green, and will not be anxious in the year of drought, nor will cease from yielding fruit.”

What God is saying to the people of Judah is true concerning all of humanity. Trust placed solely in one’s own knowledge or the knowledge of human learning will leave one parched and shortsighted. Trust in the Lord, and reliance on God’s wisdom will lead to a blessed life.

We have a choice as to where our trust will be placed. We, by our choices and actions, decide who knows more about life, the creator or the creation. Even though our choices may be wrong we still have a choice. Right or wrong we make choices every day.

Are we blessed simply because we are Christians? Ephesians 1:3 states, “Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly *places* in Christ.” It would seem, at first glance, blessings are overtaking us at every turn just because we are Christians. We may need to take a closer look at what is meant in Ephesians.

I would suggest that while to be in Christ means that we have been blessed with every blessing, it does not mean that all of those blessings are irrespectively overtaking us regardless of the choices we make, but rather many of the blessings are in place to be procured as we walk with and trust the Lord.

Salvation may be a good example. Jesus died to save everyone. Therefore, salvation is in place for every individual on earth, but one can only experience salvation if they place their trust in Jesus as Lord and Savior. Many of the blessings that are ours can only be experienced as we place our trust in Jesus and God’s word.

Jeremiah states, in verse six, concerning persons that trust in their own strength, they “shall not see when good comes”. I’ve been a Christian for over 38 years. I know I have missed some of the good, the blessings, I could have experienced had I been trusting God instead of messing around trying to accomplish things in my own strength and knowledge. Trusting in the Lord is what we all as Christians should be learning to do. I’ll end with this thought. Blessings will overtake anyone who trusts in the Lord, and trust is a choice we face countless times every day. Trust is choosing each time to walk with Jesus and rely on His wisdom. Be blessed with every spiritual blessing.
