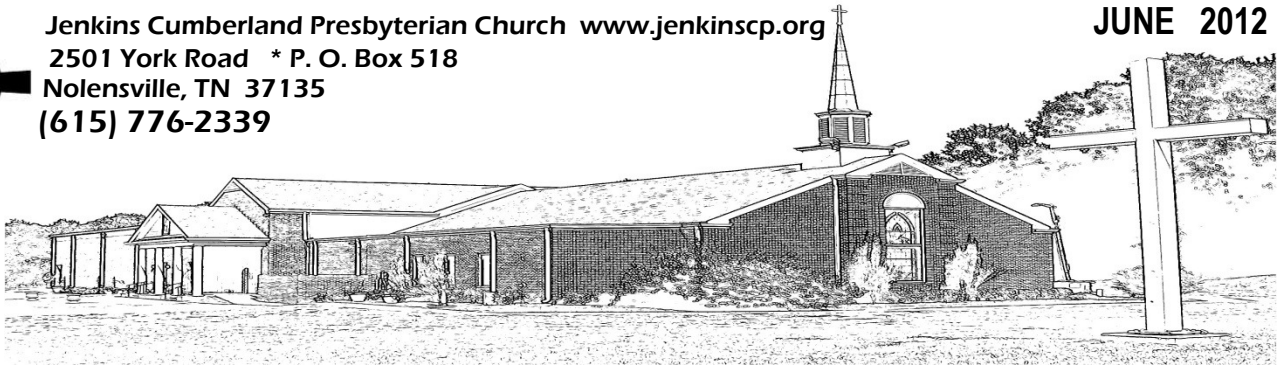

Grace

Grace has often been described as God's unmerited favor. When we talk about grace most often we focus on the unmerited aspect of grace. The human condition carries with it a strong sense of unworthiness, guilt, and condemnation. We struggle with how to overcome these feelings, yet we seem to be plagued with failure in our attempts. We will do ok for a while, and just when we start to feel better about ourselves something happens and all those old feelings of failure seem to rule our thinking once again.

I think this destructive cycle continues to be a hindrance because we are still trying to work for our merit. The unmerited aspect of grace has not fully become a revelation in our thinking, nor our hearts. Romans 12:2 encourages us to no longer conform to this world but be transformed by the renewing of our minds, so we can test and approve what God's will is. Wouldn't we love to know what God's will is during times of struggle, and even replace the struggle with the peace that comes from knowing God's will? Knowing God's will is preceded by transformed thinking. As long as we remain tangled in thoughts of unworthiness we will tend to struggle to know God's will and the peace that accompanies it.

Romans 5:8 states, "God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us." This verse reveals the unmerited aspect of grace. Christ died only for the unmerited, and Jesus died while we deserved no merit. Only the unmerited can receive grace. Merit means something that deserves or justifies a reward or commendation; a commendable quality, an act. Christ died for us while we had no merit, while we had no act that deserved a reward or commendation. Our only merit is Jesus and He is all the merit we will ever need. This is a transforming revelation we all need to take hold of and make it our own.

The other aspect of grace is favor. Grace is defined in Philippians 2:13 (NLT) "For God is working in you, giving you the desire and the power to do what pleases him." This is the beauty of grace. Grace is the God given desire and power to change the way we think, to change the choices we make, to walk in freedom instead of bondage, and to embrace truth instead of lies. Romans 6 teaches us we are free from sin, and we can and should choose to submit our members to God as instruments of righteousness. We are not trapped in sin. The spiritual reality is we are free to walk with Jesus and pattern our lives after Him. We can choose the truth of unmerited favor (God's grace) and change the way we respond to life's situations. Remember God is at work in you giving you the desire and the power to please Him.
