

Revive Us

Psalm 69:32 "When the humble see it they will be glad; you who seek God, let your hearts revive."

Isaiah 57:15 "For thus says the One who is high and lifted up, who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy: 'I dwell in the high and holy place, and also with him who is of a contrite and lowly spirit, to revive the spirit of the lowly, and to revive the heart of the contrite.'"

The definition of revive is to live, have life, remain alive, sustain life, live prosperously, live forever, be quickened, be alive, be restored to life or health. Have you ever had a fingernail tear into the quick? That area of the nail is called the quick because it is alive with nerve endings and it is painful. None of us enjoy pain but at least we know we are alive.

To revive is to be restored to life. To be restored to life, suggests we were alive and are now being reinvigorated with life. In order to be revived one must be 'vived' already. We have been made alive (vived) in Christ Jesus, but at times we grow weary in our Christian walk and we need to be re-vived.

What is the secret to being revived? Humility is central. The psalmist believes those who are humble "see it". What is "it"? "It", is the way, the truth, and the life, God's word, God's perspective on the situation, and one's own faults and shortcomings. Through humility, spiritual sight is given to those who were blind beforehand. The blind struggle to find their way, but sight makes the path sure. Humility is the daily act of laying self aside and seeking God with the whole heart. Our eyes are opened and we see truths we previously missed. Humility is totally leaning on God for all things.

Isaiah assures us God is in two places. God is in His holy place and God is with the lowly and contrite. God comes to revive the spirit of the lowly and the heart of the contrite. God is the one who revives, and our spirit needs reviving. We need God to revive our hearts. Humbleness of heart is our key to being revived. May we lay aside our own agenda and seek God with all our heart. It is time to lay aside all petty arguments, all gossiping, foolish pride, and the like. God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble. Humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God. The humbling of one's self begins with confession and repentance. This is the key to revival.

2 Chronicles 7:14 "If my people who are called by my name humble themselves, and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and heal their land."
