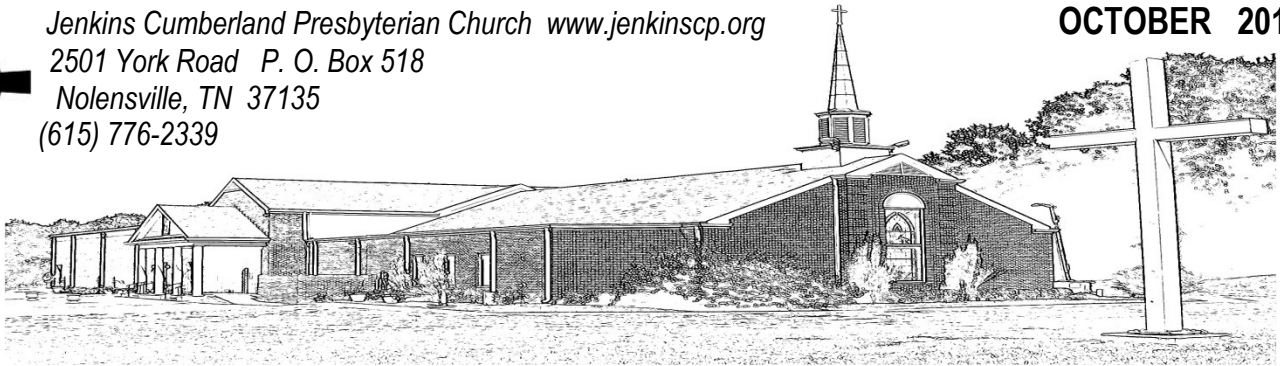

I have led groups to Colombia, Guatemala, one group came to Nolensville to help Tommy Marcum, another group helped build 20 bunk beds and install the floor for the new Woodbine Lodge at Crystal Springs Camp.

Our trips to Guatemala and Iloilo are also relationship building with the churches the Cumberland Presbyterian denomination missions team is establishing there. The church in Guatemala is named Comunidad de Fe (Community of Faith), and our missionary there is Anay Ortega who has spoken at our church. We have 3 churches on the island of Iloilo in the Philippines, and our missionary there is Daniel Jang. I am looking forward to the first Grace Team trip to Asia. We will be helping to remodel a new location for one of the churches there.

I have missed being at Jenkins these last few weeks, but God calls us to ministry, and I have been chosen to do this work, and God is blessing the work of the Grace Team and those we go to serve.
