

Vision

"Where there is no prophetic vision the people cast off restraint, but blessed is he who keeps the law." Proverbs 29:18

"Prophetic vision" The Hebrew word, "khä-zōn" means "vision" but this definition does not refer simply to sight but specifically to "divine revelation", or "prophetic vision" which in layman's terms means, "a word from God that gives direction for one's future". So, where there is no word from God that gives direction for the future of God's people, they will cast off restraint or, having no framework for obedience and no expectation to rise to, they will do whatever they please no matter how far outside the bounds of God's holiness their actions may lead them.

On the other hand, "blessed is the one who keeps the law". The law for Israel was the prophetic word of God. The law was and is divine revelation. Jesus fulfilled the divine revelation of God completely as the perfect sacrifice for sin, and declared that revelation fulfilled in two commands. Love the Lord your God with all your heart, soul, mind, & strength, and love your neighbor as yourself. Now, the church has been given a New Testament, a new testimony revealing the prophetic vision for the New Testament church. God has given the church a new vision.

God's new vision, like the old, continues to call us to love God and each other, but the new vision sheds that love abroad in our hearts through faith in Jesus. It empowers us with the presence of the Holy Spirit and emboldens us to witness and testify. The new vision calls us to share the love of God in Christ Jesus with the world and make disciples.

Churches spend lots of hours and money coming up with catchy ways to dress up and/or simplify the mission and vision of the church, but in the end the mission and vision of every church is clear. We are called to be faithful, love-filled, disciples of Jesus our whole life.

A disciple by definition is one who accepts and assists in spreading the doctrines of another. When we accept the doctrines or teaching of Jesus we are declaring these teaching as the guiding principles for our own lives. When we assist in spreading the teachings of Jesus we are witnessing and making disciples of others. The new vision of the church has these three pillars at its foundation. A disciple witnesses by exemplifying a Christ-like lifestyle, by telling others about Jesus and his love, and by teaching others how to follow Jesus.
