

Does Being a Member of a Church Really Matter?

Why should a Christian become a member of a local church? Here are 5 misconceptions about becoming a member of a local church:

- 1. Church membership will get you into heaven.
- 2. Church membership is a status symbol, a "Who's Who Contest".
- 3. Church membership is like becoming a member of a club that has membership dues, business meetings, and service projects.
- 4. Church membership is just a silly creation of man, created so denominations can brag about numbers.
- 5. "Why should I become a member if I'm already a member of the body of Christ?"

I think the term "membership" is largely responsible for many of the misconceptions stated above. The idea of "joining a local congregation" may start to move us closer to a biblical understanding of what it means to be a church member. A man and woman are joined together in the holy covenant of marriage. The word "joined" in the context of marriage represents the covenant bond that is created when two people vow to love and support each other. Covenant relationship is what we really mean when we talk about church membership, and covenant relationship is not a creation of man but of God.

David and Jonathan's relationship in the Old Testament (Old Covenant) is a wonderful model that illustrates the importance of church membership (covenant). David and Jonathan were both Israelites, which means they were both covenant members of the Israelite family of God having been circumcised on the eighth day of each of their births. It would be correct to state that Jonathan and David were covenant brothers and yet they sought to form another covenant together once they became friends.

Why did they feel it so important to form another covenant? David had just killed Goliath and was brought before Saul with the head of Goliath in hand to present to the King. 1 Samuel 18:1-4 states that when David finished speaking to the king, the soul of Jonathan was knit to David. Jonathan and David made a covenant, and Jonathan gave David his robe, his armor, his sword, his bow, and his belt. We know from the events that followed this covenant, it was a brotherly bond of deep importance to both of them. Jonathan warned David of his father's evil intentions toward David on more than one occasion, and even after Jonathan's death King David searched out the land to find a descendant of Jonathan's, so he could honor his covenant with Jonathan by blessing Jonathan's descendants.

They formed this covenant because God had knit them together as close friends. Everyone needs a friend they can count on and a community with which they can share. We all need relationships that challenge us, and persons who will stand with us in the heat of battle and walk with us through the storms of life. David and Jonathan were covenant brothers through circumcision, but felt compelled to form another covenant that would sustain them as they carried out their life's callings.

Christians everywhere are brothers and sisters from the moment we believe on Christ, but God brings us together at the time of His choosing so we may enter into another covenant (a church covenant) to support one another in Christian friendship and carry out ministry together.

Jonathan and David were saying "I will be there for you anytime you need me. I will uphold you in what you are doing and I believe you will uphold me the same." This is the nature of church membership today. When we join a church family we are saying to the community with which we worship and share ministry, "I commit myself to you, I will walk with you in ministry and we will support each other in the work we do together for the Lord." May each of you prayerfully consider if it is time for you and your family to commit yourselves to this church family for our mutual support and ministry.
