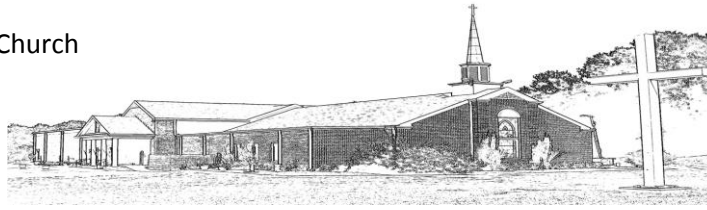

Sharing About Our Evangelism Workshop

Recently, we had an Evangelism Workshop at the church on a Saturday afternoon. The workshop was the first of many such experiences we plan to offer in order to help our church family fully embrace the great commission Jesus entrusted to the church. Embracing the great commission has the power to elevate our fears, embolden us for the task, and change how we think about sharing the good news with others. Here are some interesting statistics presented during the Evangelism workshop. The late Bill Bright, founder of Campus Crusade for Christ, reported an alarming statistic that **only 2% of believers regularly share their faith with others.** Dr. D. James Kennedy also concluded from a study that **only 5% of Christians ever lead someone to Jesus.** Another poll asked Christians if they felt they had a personal responsibility to share their faith with others. The results among **Catholics, 81% felt they had no personal responsibility to share their faith with others, and 53% of Protestants agreed.**

I believe these statistics reveal at least three possible problems. First, we may not know what the bible says about the need for evangelism. Second, we may not believe the word of God concerning evangelism. Third, and most likely the case for most of us, we are simply afraid. During the workshop we talked about six cures to the fears that paralyze us. **1) Remind yourself of what awaits the unrighteous. Matthew 25:41-46; 2) Jesus has all authority in heaven and on the earth Matthew 28:18-19; 3) God will be with you Matthew 28:20; 4) Know Your Message 2 Timothy 2:15; 5) Remember how God has powerfully worked in your life Deut. 7:17-21 6) Pray for boldness Acts 4:19-20**

We taught a simple approach to having a conversation with anyone about Jesus. We began with the understanding that God often puts us in situations where we have the opportunity to talk with someone who may be hurting, going through a time when they are not in fellowship with God, or we may have a strong impression we are talking with a non-believer. How should we proceed to see if there is an opportunity to share our faith?

Simply show genuine concern and listen carefully as we began asking questions. People enjoy talking about themselves and our genuine interest in them builds trust in our relationship. Ask a few questions about their day, their interests or hobbies. Listen and we will know when the time is right to begin asking questions concerning faith. **There are five questions worth remembering so we can ask.** They are non-threatening questions and the key is to simply listen and not think we have to have answers or responses other than those that demonstrate we are listening such as "Hummm!" or "Thanks for sharing your thoughts with me". **Our goal is to let them talk and share their views while we listen. We are attempting to hear their heart.** Once you feel they have answered the question move to the next question. **1) Do you have any spiritual beliefs? 2) Who is Jesus Christ to you? 3) Do you believe in Heaven or Hell? 4) If you were to die, where would you go? 5) If what you believe is not true, would you want to know?** The answer to question five will let you know if they would like to hear your response. If they say "no" we should respect their wish, but most people say "yes". Why? Because we have truly listened, and they feel we have valued their opinions. Therefore, they are open to hear our story.

We taught a very simple approach to sharing the Gospel. It is called the Roman Road. One way to use this approach is to start with John 3:16 and in the margin of your bible write the reference to the next scripture Romans 3:23 and do the same thing with each preceding scripture. You could also record each of these scriptures in your phone for easy reference or make a card to carry in your car, purse or wallet.

The Roman Road (Sharing the Gospel using the Book of Romans)

John 3:16; Romans 3:23 "for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,"; **Romans 5:8** "when we were in our sin Christ Jesus came to die for us,"; **Romans 6:23** "For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord,"; **Romans 10:9-10** "if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved; for with the heart a person believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation."
