Bandages Can Merely Cover Problems But Not Hide Them

Never put a bandage on a sore and think it will heal on its own. One needs to continue to check the wound area to see if it is healing properly. Using bandages is always helpful in keeping debris and dirt from getting into the wound. But if one continues to ignore and not take proper care to change bandages and clean the wound area, infection can set up again and become much harder to deal with. The same thing can happen to a person who is merely putting up a phony front trying to convince others around that he or she **has got it all together**. This cover-up is not dealing with reality but living a counterfeit life. This only exasperates matters, and one cannot find true healing or inner peace if he or she does not expose the problem area and confront it with the truth.

The Cure!

Bacteria-killing solutions help wash away germs and dirt; in the same manner, we need a spiritual cleansing to help with the removal of sin. This can only happen through personally knowing the Great Physician, Jesus. He is the **Way the Truth and the Life. (John 14:6)** He is the only way we can find true healing and inner peace. He cleanses us from all the decaying tissue of our past and will mend us to wholeness. **Isaiah 53:4-5, "Surely He has borne our sicknesses and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed."**

A well trained staff and team!

Many times doctors refer to other physicians or medical staff to help make a diagnosis and identify any problems the patient may have. The Great Physician has no need to go to anyone else for advice, but He does have a team of angels that can go and minister where ever He sends them. **Hebrews 1:14 "Are they not all ministering spirits sent forth to minister for those who will inherit salvation?"** The Great Physician also has an assistant on His team much more superior to any nurse. He is the Holy Spirit who is also referred to as the Helper. The Helper can comfort us and decrease the inflammation of life's pain when we have been emotionally or spiritually wounded. He can give us the power to overcome spiritual strongholds and lies that keep us from knowing the truth of God. It is His job to lead us into all the truth. **John 16:13 "However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own [authority], but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come."**

Powerful medicine!

Just like an antibiotic that helps prevent infections, **prayer** can help us avoid the infectious lure of sin and temptation. This intimate communication gives us a direct line to the Great Physician, His well trained staff and miracle team. When we pray we are actually inviting God to get involved in the issues of our heart. Adding scripture to prayer is like taking a powerful injection of truth directly to the vascular system. It opens up an avenue of miraculous healing to the mind and heart. **Hebrews 4:12 "For the word of God [is] living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart."**
