## James 5:1-12

Come now, you rich, weep and howl for your miseries which are coming upon you. <sup>2</sup>Your riches have rotted and your garments have become moth-eaten. <sup>3</sup>gold and your silver have rusted; and their rust will be a witness against you and will consume your flesh like fire. It is in the last days that you have stored up your treasure! <sup>4</sup>Behold, the pay of the laborers who mowed your fields, *and* which has been withheld by you, cries out *against you*; and the outcry of those who did the harvesting has reached the ears of the Lord of Sabaoth. <sup>5</sup>You have lived luxuriously on the earth and led a life of wanton pleasure; you have fattened your hearts in a day of slaughter. <sup>6</sup>You have condemned and put to death the righteous *man*; he does not resist you.

<sup>7</sup>Therefore be patient, brethren, until the coming of the Lord. The farmer waits for the precious produce of the soil, being patient about it, until it gets the early and late rains. <sup>8</sup>You too be patient; strengthen your hearts, for the coming of the Lord is near. <sup>9</sup>Do not complain, brethren, against one another, so that you yourselves may not be judged; behold, the Judge is standing right at the door. <sup>10</sup>As an example, brethren, of suffering and patience, take the prophets who spoke in the name of the Lord. <sup>11</sup>We count those blessed who endured. You have heard of the endurance of Job and have seen the outcome of the Lord's dealings, that the Lord is full of compassion and *is* merciful. <sup>12</sup>But above all, my brethren, do not swear, either by heaven or by earth or with any other oath; but your yes is to be yes, and your no, no, so that you may not fall under judgment.

## Preparing to Perceive

I want to thank everyone for your participation in talking to your elders about the mission, vision, and daily function of the church. We hope there will be many more wonderful insights God will lay on your heart to share. The elected elders and I feel strongly each of you should know your voice is important to the life and health of this church. The elders have asked that you would please continue to be in contact with them, and know that each meeting of the elders is open for anyone to come and bring important issues to our attention.

The Presbyterian form of government we employ means your elders have been elected by you to represent the entire body of the church and provide Spirit-led leadership for the good of the church as we seek to serve Jesus together. Communication between elders and congregation is essential for our form of government to be highly effective. This type of communication provides the assurance of success spoken of in **Proverbs 15:22** "Without consultation, plans are frustrated, But with many counselors they succeed."

The consideration of wise counsel and prayerful deliberation has led us to the decision to return to one worship service beginning the first Sunday in August. Sunday school will begin at 9am and worship will begin at 10:15am. We believe it is important, going forward, for our congregation to enjoy one unified worship event for our present size congregation. We must minister to our members and seek to reach our community. Therefore, we decided it would be in the best interest of our congregation to worship in ways that combine elements that are important to our present members and those we seek to reach. The input of the congregation has been invaluable in the discernment process leading to these decisions.

The decision to place one worship service at 10:15 will allow for a second early morning worship event as anticipated growth calls for the actual need for two worship events. We must anticipate growth as we move forward. Nolensville is growing and we should expect growth and the change that comes with it. Looking to the future and preparing for it means much time in prayer looking to God to build His house. We will need to move forward together allowing God to use us as the tools for building His church. It will take all of us working together, each one doing his or her part. I hope you are ready to move forward together.

Revival services start August 11<sup>th</sup> going through August 13<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm each evening. I hope everyone will mark this special series of services on their calendar. These services can be our special time to start moving forward together. The book of Isaiah records these wonderful words of God in chapter 43:18&19. "Remember not the former things, nor consider the things of old. Behold, I am doing a new thing; now it springs forth, do you not perceive it." I believe God is ready to do a new thing at Jenkins. We need to position ourselves before the Lord in such a way as to be ready to perceive the new thing God is doing in our midst. May we use this time of revival to humble ourselves before our God, and may God grant us ears to hear, and eyes open to see and perceive both the words and deeds of Almighty God.
