Come now, you rich, weep and howl for your miseries which are coming upon you. ² Your riches have rotted and your garments have become moth-eaten. ³ gold and your silver have rusted; and their rust will be a witness against you and will consume your flesh like fire. It is in the last days that you have stored up your treasure! ⁴ Behold, the pay of the laborers who mowed your fields, *and* which has been withheld by you, cries out *against you*; and the outcry of those who did the harvesting has reached the ears of the Lord of Sabaoth. ⁵ You have lived luxuriously on the earth and led a life of wanton pleasure; you have fattened your hearts in a day of slaughter. ⁶ You have condemned and-put to death the righteous *man*; he does not resist you.

⁷ Therefore be patient, brethren, until the coming of the Lord. I want to thank everyone for your participation in talking to your elders about the mission, vision, and daily function of the church. We hope there will be many more wonderful insights God will lay on your heart to share. The elected elders and I feel strongly each of you should know your voice is important to the life and health of this church.
