PRAYER GARDEN BRICK PAVERS ARE NOW AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE

We are pleased to announce the purchase of memorial and honorary brick pavers for the new prayer garden to be constructed outside the south doors of the vestibule. We wish to create a beautiful quiet area which emphasizes the importance of prayer.

A place where one can commune with God in nature, and remember loved ones who have finished their race and honor those whom we love. There are order forms available to be completed. Each brick paver can have three lines of text with 18 characters on each line. The 18 characters include spaces, commas, quotations mark, etc...

Brick pavers are \$50.00 each. The funds collected from your purchases will be used to pay for the brick pavers and their engraving, and the cost of construction of the prayer garden. A pergola is to be constructed the length of the sidewalk just outside the south entrance. The prayer garden with brick pavers will be constructed on the other side of the sidewalk that runs the length of the sanctuary. Beautiful landscaping (in part to hide the light pole and gas tank) will be a part of this project, prayer benches, a cross that can be seen from the vestibule, and moving the gas tank further to the west will be involved in the 1st phase of this project.



Living Before God with No Regrets

I look around at the families and individuals in our church, from the wisest among us to the young families, children and youth growing in grace and truth, and the new families coming into our church and I praise God for His amazing grace. I am encouraged when I think about all God can do through us in this New Year.

We often hear it said that our children are the church of tomorrow, but in truth our children are the church right now. The ministries we are performing for them right now and ministries they are engaged in through the life of the church will drastically affect their future decision to stay involved in church and continue their walk with God wherever God may lead them.

We have seen too many youth in years gone by grow up and leave church-life behind altogether. Some of us left as soon as we were old enough to make our own decisions, only to return later with many regrets about time wasted in unfaithfulness to God.

The church plays a big part in preparation as a lighthouse, a beacon for all to hear the good news of Jesus Christ, and a place where the hungry can find the fresh bread of God's word and strength of His Spirit. Church needs to be a place where all can be refreshed and renewed, a place to grow in wisdom and the knowledge of God. The church also needs to take its light and love out into the community to be a testimony of God's grace. It takes all of us working together. It takes commitment of our time, talents, and resources to build a community of faith where everyone can flourish.

We are at the beginning of a new year and I am asking each of you to invest yourselves in Kingdom works both in and outside the walls of the church. Make it your goal to bring someone new to church, and after you have brought one continue to bring others.
