#### THIRTY HOUR FAMINE

Jenkins Youth will be attending the 2nd Annual Presbyterial 30 Hour Famine on February 21-22, at Lebanon CP Church. Fasting begins after lunch (around 12:30pm) on Friday and ends at 6:30pm on Saturday.

30 Hour Famine is a fundraising effort of World Vision to generate awareness as well as financial support to combat hunger all around the world. This year we will also be partnering with Stop Hunger Now. They will be leading us in our service project that will be held at Murfreesboro CPC on Saturday.

While this event has no cost, each participant is REQUIRED to raise at least \$60 to attend! All proceeds go to World Vision and Stop Hunger Now. The event will offer times of fun, fellowship, worship and service. We will be monitoring each participant's well-being and providing "juice breaks" throughout the event. 30 Hour Famine is open to youth in grades 6-12, and youth must be at least 12 years old to participate.
