#### ROCK CITY MINISTRY DESCRIPTIONS CALL SUNDAY SEPTEMBER 7th

Today please take time to look over each ministry description, prayerfully consider where you should be involved in this ministry, and place your name under the area of ministry you feel so called to serve. Today, September 7th we will provide an opportunity for everyone to place their call in the offering plate as we give to the Lord not only of our resources but of our time and talents. Thank you.

### **MINISTRY OPPORTUNITIES**

<u>Set-up Team</u> – Set up tables and chairs each Tuesday afternoon. Time 30 - 40 minutes.

**<u>Theme Team</u>** – Decorate tables & room according to the theme of the week and set tables with dinner wear. Decorating Tuesday night or Wed. Time 60 minutes

**Dinner Dean** – Directs the activities of the dinner time by making announcements, picking table servers, planning table games, and group activities to make the dinner time fun and flow smooth. Meet with table parents five minutes early for direction and prayer.

<u>**Table Parents**</u> –A table parent interacts in conversation and table games with the children or youth at your table making sure everyone feels included. A table parent gets the awesome opportunity to build relationships with the children throughout both semesters. Time 50 minutes

**<u>Cooking Team</u>** – This team prepares meal plans in conjunction with the Leadership team, purchases and delivers food to the church, and prepares meals for each Rock City.

<u>Tear Down Team</u> - This team puts the gym back in proper order after the dinner hour so it is ready for MDO. Tear down personnel please be sensitive to when you begin due to noise and distraction from dinner time. If games are at other end of gym you are good to go to work.

<u>Clean-Up Team</u> – This team takes charge in the kitchen after dinner time to clean dishes pots and pans.

<u>Activity Team</u> – This team leads in games, crafts, projects and learning activities. 25 minute class

<u>Worship Team</u> – This team leads in teaching worship skills such as singing as a choir, teaching about different segments of our order of worship, their history, and symbolism. Class participation: to lead a segment of Sunday worship periodically. 25 minute class

<u>Bible Study Team</u> – This team learns bible study for each age group. Material will be provided. 25 minute class

## Harvest America October 5th

Harvest America is an annual live nationwide event, streamed to thousands of host locations including churches, theaters, and living rooms. Harvest America is more than just a webcast, it is the body of Christ banding together to proclaim the gospel live across the nation.

The goal of Harvest America is to impact a nation desperately in need of hope. The event features top Christian artists and a clear gospel message by Greg Laurie.

Greg Laurie is the senior pastor of Harvest Christian Fellowship in Riverside, California and Harvest Orange County in Irvine, California. He began his pastoral ministry at the age of 19 by leading a Bible study of 30 people. Since then, God has transformed that small group into a church of some 15,000 people. Today, Harvest is one of the largest churches in America.

In 1990, Greg Laurie began holding large-scale public evangelistic events called Harvest Crusades. Since that time, more than 5,122,708 people have attended Harvest Crusades events around the United States and internationally. More than 434,625 people have registered professions of faith through these outreaches.

Our church will serve as host for a Harvest America event Sunday evening October 5th. The service will begin at 6 pm and conclude at 7:30 pm. I am asking that we each take advantage of this opportunity to bring those we are praying for to an event designed to make clear the message of hope in Jesus our Lord. Here are three simple steps to help make this a life changing event for those we bring.

#### Three simple steps:

- **Pray** for those you know who do not yet have a personal relationship with Jesus
- Invite those you have been praying for to the Harvest America event October 5th.

There are many different ways to invite people to attend the Harvest America event with you. You can use the Harvest America printed invite we will make available, you can call, send a text message, or use social media to invite people to attend this life changing event. The more personal the better, and multiple methods serve as a good reminder.

• **Bring** those you have been praying for to the event and then bring them back to church with you the following Sunday. Offering to pick someone up and bring them to the event can be an effective means of making sure they attend. You not only help them get to the event, but you help make sure they do not forget or get distracted by something else.
