TONIGHT HARVEST AMERICA OCTOBER 5TH 2014

Harvest America is an annual live nationwide event, streamed to thousands of host locations including churches, theaters, and living rooms. Harvest America is more than just a webcast, it is the body of Christ banding together to proclaim the gospel live across the nation.

The goal of Harvest America is to impact a nation desperately in need of hope. The event features top Christian artists and a clear gospel message by Greg Laurie. Greg Laurie is the senior pastor of Harvest Christian Fellowship in Riverside, California and Harvest Orange County in Irvine, California. He began his pastoral ministry at the age of 19 by leading a Bible study of 30 people. Since then, God has transformed that small group into a church of some 15,000 people. Today, Harvest is one of the largest churches in America.

Our church will serve as host for a Harvest America Event THIS Sunday evening October 5th. The service will begin at 6 pm and conclude at 7:30 pm. I am asking that we each take advantage of this opportunity to bring those we are praying for to an event designed to make clear the message of hope in Jesus our Lord. Child Care will be available.
