THE HARVEST

When thinking about the Fall season, many words and pictures come to mind – one in particular is the word "harvest", which means "to gather". Many people consider the harvest the end of a particular growing season, but if you think about it, the church never stops harvesting. We are constantly gathering in small or large groups, for many different purposes, to share talents, to laugh and cry with each other, to learn, to teach, to be a part of something greater. We are constantly welcoming new people in and making them a part of our church family.

Another way to look at it is that we are in the growing season. We are always growing in numbers, but more importantly growing in our relationship with Christ. We are constantly learning about God's love through other people's actions, things that happen in our lives whether good or bad, and most importantly studying the Word. It is amazing how one verse can show us how much God loves us!

In 1 Corinthians 3:5-9, we will learn that a fruitful harvest requires a faithful witness. Paul writes, "What then is Apollos? And what is Paul? Servants through whom you believed, even as the Lord gave opportunity to each one. I planted, Apollos watered, but God was causing the growth. So then neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but God who causes the growth. Now he who plants and he who waters are one; but each will receive his own reward according to his own labor. For we are God's fellow workers; you are God's field, God's building."

First, we are servants. We are nothing in and of ourselves. We are simply God's mouthpieces through whom people come to believe.

Second, we all have different roles and responsibilities in God's garden. Some plant, some water, some have up-front gifts, and some serve behind the scenes. However, all servants are equally significant.

Third, God is the One who causes the growth. Twice in 3:6-7, Paul states, "...but God was causing the growth." We are the means by which people believe, but God is the cause. He alone determines if and when a person believes in Jesus Christ.

Fourth, we are all one in God's program. We are not to compete against each other; instead, we are to complement each other. We all need one another to fulfill God's work. To the degree that we are faithful garden tools, God will grant us eternal rewards (3:8).

Finally, we work for God. In 3:9a Paul calls us "God's fellow workers." We do not work for ourselves or even for one another; we work for God.
