A note from our Worship Ministry Leader...

I have spent countless hours pondering worship and what it means to me. A recent article from Lifeway discussed the importance of the songs we learn in worship services. The words of truth found in our hymns, praise songs, and scripture songs are mechanisms for remembering God's word. I find myself taking a different song with me each Sunday into the week. I have been humming "He is Lord" almost constantly because it was the choral opener in church. "Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father." (Phil. 2:7-11)

Okay, so what does that have to do with the Ministry of Worship? Everything! While worship is not just for Sunday mornings in formal church services, (We can worship in Sunday School, as we serve burritos to the homeless, as we take rafting trips on mighty rivers, as we drive to work, etc.) collective worship is precious and affords each of us the opportunity to affirm our beliefs in public! Is that necessary? Maybe not, but standing next to other Christians singing and praying sure helps strengthen the resolve to live for Him.
