### A note from the Pastor...

At our twice yearly Presbytery meetings, candidates for the ministry often give the day's devotion. It's a way of introducing themselves to the presbytery while giving glory to God. It's usually intimidating for the preachers-in-preparation because they are preaching in front of what will become their peers. What do you preach to people who preach every Sunday?

This past meeting the honor went to Rev. Hone Phillips, an ordained minister of the Reformed Churches of New Zealand who desires to be ordained in the Cumberland Presbyterian Church, and he showed us that he had no fear at all to preach!

His sermon introduced the idea that Jesus explained to the world exactly who God is. In it he said that when Jesus walked and talked and lived and taught and healed and on and on, what he was also doing was revealing God to the world so that if someone took a look, they discern what God is about.

I'd heard before that to know Jesus is to know God but somehow that never really grabbed me like maybe it should.

Yet, when Rev. Phillips said it like he did, his words sunk into me and told me a truth I don't think I'd really grasped before. If you want to know the intimate thoughts of God, God's motivations, God's values, and what God finds important, it is readily available. You just have to see what Jesus showed us.

I think the temptation (or sadly, what we've often been taught) is that all we must do is know that Jesus was God in the flesh, and believe he died on a cross for us, only to be resurrected. We are deceived and think that to know that is to know enough.

Rev. Phillips reminded us that it is not though. To truly know God is to become intimate with the scriptures so that we can know exactly what it is that Jesus did. When we know what he taught, we know what God needs us to know. When we know what he did, we learn what God finds it good to do. When we know how he lived, we can find our own path to walk in the world.

To know Jesus is to know what God is all about. As Rev. Hone Phillips preached, I came to realize the depth of that statement.

Might we all need to be reminded that had Jesus' death and resurrection been all that mattered, he could have died as a baby, and been raised up then? So that can't be all there is.

The rest of the story is that God gave us a way to know all we need to know about God, when Jesus lived among us.

So let us learn more, by studying Jesus in scripture. Let us learn all we can, so that we can better know God, and come to love God even more.

For their love, sacrifice, struggle and joy, we thank you.

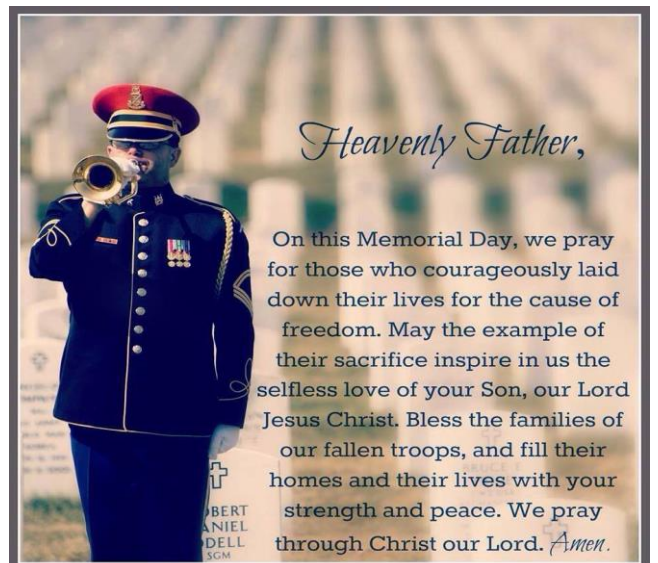

- Registration Fee - \$340

### WHAT TO EXPECT AT CPYC!

- **Morning Mash-Up** - A whole group activity including an introduction to the daily theme, group singing, energizers, keynote speaker, and announcements.
- **Discussion Groups** - Theme exploration and biblical discovery through various learning techniques in small groups meeting daily, led by adult and peer leaders and concentrating on daily sub-themes where discussion and questions are encouraged.
- **Worship** - A whole group gathering of further theological and biblical reflection of the daily theme through music, drama, scripture, and preaching. Worship concludes with quiet time. Holy communion will be served one evening.
- **Recreation** - Afternoon recreation and free time consists of numerous options. The CPYC "lounge" is an indoor area with cards, games, and creative activities. Every day there are different options of organized games/sports & activities, pickup games or swimming. Participation is by sign-up sheets or free-flowing, with announcements & explanations given daily. Evening recreation is an organized, whole group activity and will be something different each night.
- **Prayer Center** - A come-and-go center of prayer stations, thematically organized, open during afternoon free time and after worship.
- **Suite Time** - A time of sharing and daily reflection with suitemates and suite counselor.
- **Housing** - All participants are housed in one dorm. Youth can choose one or two other participants with whom to room, but we do try to house larger groups together if possible. Each suite houses 6 participants plus an adult counselor. Boys and girls are housed in separate wings and are not allowed in the wing of the opposite gender.
- **Staff** - There will be a staff to camper ratio of about 1:4, which doesn't include the adult youth worker participants who bring their youth. A nurse will be on staff.
- **Experience** - The most important thing about CPYC is the *experience* of being part of a larger group of young people and purposefully forming one faith community, regardless of differences. Youth who attend alone or for the first time will quickly receive hospitality and feel at home. The hospitality, love of neighbor and love of God is a life changing experience.
