Mark 5:21-43

A Girl Restored to Life and a Woman Healed

²¹ When Jesus had crossed again in the boat to the other side, a great crowd gathered around him; and he was by the sea. ²² Then one of the leaders of the synagogue named Jairus came and, when he saw him, fell at his feet ²³ and begged him repeatedly, "My little daughter is at the point of death. Come and lay your hands on her, so that she may be made well, and live." ²⁴ So he went with him.

And a large crowd followed him and pressed in on him. ²⁵ Now there was a woman who had been suffering from hemorrhages for twelve years. ²⁶ She had endured much under many physicians, and had spent all that she had; and she was no better, but rather grew worse. ²⁷ She had heard about Jesus, and came up behind him in the crowd and touched his cloak, ²⁸ for she said, "If I but touch his clothes, I will be made well." ²⁹ Immediately her hemorrhage stopped; and she felt in her body that she was healed of her disease. ³⁰ Immediately aware that power had gone forth from him, Jesus turned about in the crowd and said, "Who touched my clothes?" ³¹ And his disciples said to him, "You see the crowd pressing in on you; how can you say, 'Who touched me?'" ³² He looked all around to see who had done it. ³³ But the woman, knowing what had happened to her, came in fear and trembling, fell down before him, and told him the whole truth. ³⁴ He said to her, "Daughter, your faith has made you well; go in peace, and be healed of your disease." ³⁵ While he was still speaking, some people came from the leader's house to say, "Your daughter is dead. Why trouble the teacher any further?" ³⁶ But overhearing what they said, Jesus said to the leader of the synagogue, "Do not fear, only believe." ³⁷ He allowed no one to follow him except Peter, James, and John, the brother of James. ³⁸ When they came to the house of the leader of the synagogue, he saw a commotion, people weeping and wailing loudly. ³⁹ When he had entered, he said to them, "Why do you make a commotion and weep? The child is not dead but sleeping." ⁴⁰ And they laughed at him. Then he put them all outside, and took the child's father and mother and those who were with him, and went in where the child was. ⁴¹ He took her by the hand and said to her, "Talitha cum," which means, "Little girl, get up!" ⁴² And immediately the girl got up and began to walk about (she was twelve years of age). At this they were overcome with amazement. ⁴³ He strictly ordered them that no one should know this, and told them to give her something to eat.

I've heard it said that sports is just soap operas for people who don't watch soap operas. As a sports fan, there seems to me there's some truth in that. It's just sort of a manufactured way of feeling emotions that we don't always allow ourselves to feel.

Literally on the final play of the game last week, Germany rescued their World Cup hopes. (Yes, I know, it's a risky move making a soccer reference. Stay with me.) The game was tied, and if it stayed tied when the referee called the game which would come after this play, Germany would probably not advance to the next stage of the tournament.

But that's when Toni Kroos put the country on his right foot and sailed a perfect ball into the top right corner of the net. Germany wins. Germany moves on.

A Message from Jackie:

First, I just want to thank everyone who has contributed to the Outreach fund or has donated supplies for projects. Jenkins Church is definitely a blessing to the Nolensville community, as well as to others in need. Your support is very much appreciated!!

You may remember back at the beginning of the year that we mentioned little Layla McCormack who is one of our Mother's Day Out students. Her family lives here in Nolensville – dad is a firefighter in Nashville, mom stays at home and she has a younger and older brother. Layla has a condition/disability and her family was trying to raise money to take her to Boston so that she could undergo some treatments/clinical trial. They had a go fund me page, as well as doing some fundraising on their own. We were able to donate \$450 for their cause and I am happy to report they will be going to Boston this fall for 2 weeks – everything is paid for!!! There is a wonderful picture of Layla along with a thank you note in the bulletin board by the gym.

The Warren family had a total loss of their home from a fire on Memorial Day weekend. The Nolensville community as a whole has embraced them with donations. First Tennessee Bank had an account set up for them to help with their needs. As a whole, we were able to donate a total of \$750 to them. \$565 of that was money to the First Tennessee account, the rest was in supplies I purchased at Target.

Last week we were able to help a single mom with 2 children who is working 2 jobs and still struggling because dad isn't paying child support. We were able to give her 2 boxes of food, some gas gift cards, as well as paying her electric bill for the month of May (which was overdue). She hadn't received a bill for the month of June yet, so that may be something that we look at again.

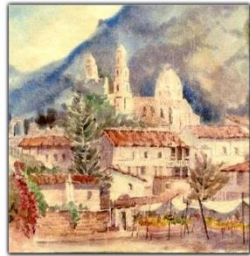
