²⁴ So when the crowd saw that neither Jesus nor his disciples were there, they themselves got into the boats and went to Capernaum looking for Jesus.

²⁵ When they found him on the other side of the sea, they said to him, "Rabbi, when did you come here?" ²⁶ Jesus answered them, "Very truly, I tell you, you are looking for me, not because you saw signs, but because you ate your fill of the loaves. ²⁷ Do not work for the food that perishes, but for the food that endures for eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. For it is on him that God the Father has set his seal." ²⁸ Then they said to him, "What must we do to perform the works of God?" ²⁹ Jesus answered them, "This is the work of God, that you believe in him whom he has sent." ³⁰ So they said to him, "What sign are you going to give us then, so that we may see it and believe you? What work are you performing?" ³¹ Our ancestors ate the manna in the wilderness; as it is written, 'He gave them bread from heaven to eat.'" ³² Then Jesus said to them, "Very truly, I tell you, it was not Moses who gave you the bread from heaven, but it is my Father who gives you the true bread from heaven. ³³ For the bread of God is that which comes down from heaven and gives life to the world." ³⁴ They said to him, "Sir, give us this bread always." ³⁵ Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never be hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty."

A note from the Pastor...

In worship Sunday, I rolled a cut out of a big tree down front of the church and challenged us all to "put leaves on the tree." Those leaves will hold the names of the children that we are pledging to bring to church on Sept 9 for the kickoff of Jenkins Kids children's ministry. Each Sunday we are going to pray that this tree fill up with leaves over the next 4 weeks. I ask that we all be in prayer about which children we will invite. As I heard recently, we are fishers of men and you can't fish until you throw in a line. Who will you invite?

When you have your name or names, come down front either before worship, after worship, during our Passing of the Peace, or dare I say even during the offering. A pen and sticky leaf will be available. Write the child's name on the leaf and put it on the tree wherever you want it. Make a statement with it that you'll disciple a child in the way of Jesus Christ.

Now, some of us are going to have a harder time finding a child to invite. That's just reality. If you are like me and worrying about who it is you're going to ask, call me or drop by. Let's talk about ideas. I have a couple that I need help with. Maybe you have an idea or two as well. If we work together, we might just do some great things in this Kingdom of God. Give me a call, an email, or a visit. I look forward to it.

Finally, let's do this all for the right reasons. We live in a world that needs Jesus. There are all kinds of gods convincing children to follow them. There all kinds of rulers demanding that they follow worldly paths. Jesus though calls us to follow a radically way, one that is foolishness to the world, but perfect in God's will. It's the one that calls us to love God and love our neighbor as much as we love ourselves.

So, find a child, and put leaves on the tree, and do it in the name of your Lord.
