Sermon Scripture for the Week is Hosea 11:1-9

God's Compassion Despite Israel's Ingratitude

11 When Israel was a child, I loved him, and out of Egypt I called my son.² The more I called them, the more they went from me, they kept sacrificing to the Baals, and offering incense to idols.

³ Yet it was I who taught Ephraim to walk, I took them up in my arms; but they did not know that I healed them.⁴ I led them with cords of human kindness, with bands of love. I was to them like those who lift infants to their cheeks. I bent down to them and fed them.⁵ They shall return to the land of Egypt, and Assyria shall be their king, because they have refused to return to me.⁶ The sword rages in their cities, it consumes their oracle-priests, and devours because of their schemes.⁷ My people are bent on turning away from me. To the Most High they call, but he does not raise them up at all.⁸ How can I give you up, Ephraim? How can I hand you over, O Israel? How can I make you like Admah compassion grows warm and tender.⁹ I will not execute my fierce anger; I will not again destroy Ephraim; for I am God and no mortal, the Holy One in your midst, and I will not come in wrath.

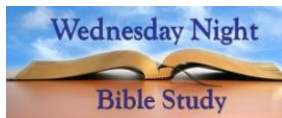
